



What is the Laveen Learning Lab?

Laveen Learning Labs provide a safe place for students with specific needs to go during the day to engage in their online/distance learning during this transitional time. They do not replace the online instruction, but rather provide a space for students to access the instruction.

Who runs the Learning Lab?

The Learning Labs are managed by Laveen non-teaching staff (instructional associates, bus drivers, etc.). The labs are not run by teachers as the teachers are all providing distance/online instruction during this time.

What hours are the Learning Labs open?

The Learning Labs will operate during the school's regular hours. Learning Labs will have limited hours on scheduled early release days. Learning Labs will be available until in-person, teacher-led instruction begins.

Where are the Learning Labs located?

Learning Labs will be located at each school site.

Is transportation provided?

Bus transportation will only be provided for special education students with transportation prescribed in the student's IEP. Parents may drop off or pick up at any time during the Learning Lab hours. Students who walk to the lab must attend for the full day.

Where on campus will the Learning Lab take place?

Each school will determine the location of their Learning Labs. Students will be broken into small groups to allow for social distancing.

Are masks required?

Yes. Participants and staff members will be required to wear masks while in the Learning Lab.

Will my child receive breaks during the Learning Lab?

The labs are simply a place for students to access instruction. The students will have breaks as scheduled in their online sessions from their classroom teachers.

Will my child be served meals at the Learning Lab?

Breakfast is served free of charge to all students as they arrive to participate in the Learning Lab. Lunch will also be provided free of charge. Students may also bring their own meals. A snack will be provided. Families are still encouraged to apply for free meals at ezmealapp.com, which will carry over into next school year.

What materials does my child need to bring?

Students must bring their district-issued Chromebook and charger with them each day in order to participate in online instruction.

Is there a dress code my child must follow?

Yes, students should wear their school uniforms each day.

Is my child expected to attend every day?

No, your child should only attend the lab if they are in need of a safe place to go that day. School attendance is not recorded through participation at the Learning Labs, but will be recorded based on participation in the online instruction provided by teachers through the Google Meet.

Do I need to check my child in each day?

Parents will be asked to sign their child in and out each day. Students in 5th grade or above who walk to school will be required to sign themselves in and out. Students will not be permitted to leave early unless accompanied by an authorized adult.
